Policy. The Polakoff Foundation uses its best efforts to respect and protect the privacy of our online visitors and donors. We will never share your name, email address, phone number, address, cause affiliation or other personal identifiable information with anyone. We will never sell, rent or trade your personal information to a third party.

Secure Information. We care about safety and security. We use high grade encryption and the https security protocol to communicate with your browser software. This method is the industry standard security protocol, which makes it extremely difficult for anyone else to intercept credit card or other personal information you send to us. Companies we work with to process credit card transactions also use high grade encryption and security protocols.

Information Accuracy. In addition to maintaining privacy and security controls over information you share with us, The Polakoff Foundation works to accurately process your contribution information. The Polakoff Foundation employs error checking procedures to make certain transactions are processed completely and accurately. As necessary, changes are made to improve our systems.

The Use of "Cookies." Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data may be automatically collected by The Polakoff Foundation site through the use of "cookies." "Cookies" are small text files a website can use to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate the visitor's ongoing access to and use of the site, and allow a site to track usage behavior and compile aggregate data that will allow content improvements. Cookies are not programs that come onto a visitor's system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. The Polakoff Foundation uses "cookie" technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve visitors' online experience and facilitate their visit within our site.
